In a small sample of data (less than 25 or so), the sample median tends to do a poor job of estimating the population median. For task-time data the geometric mean tends to provide a better estimate of the population's middle value than the sample median. Mode? The most frequently occurring value. Is useful in describing ordinal or categorical data.

As the sample size (n) gets larger, the sample means tend to follow a normal probability distribution. As the sample size (n) gets larger, the sample means tend to cluster around the true population mean. Holds true, regardless of the distribution of the population from which the sample was drawn.
